Eligibility

Clergy and Religious Leaders - sermons preached or expected to be preached.

Rules

Sermons must be the original work of the participant and must not have been published previously. Though copyright of the sermon will remain the property of the preparer, the Haworth Press, Inc. will retain rights to publish and print the sermon. The sermon must use the above mentioned theme with a length of 3,000 words or less. Submit a double-spaced printed copy along with an electronic (word document) copy of the sermon. Include a cover letter giving any significant background and specifying your religious tradition and your sermon audience. Also include a brief biography, keywords, abstract, and contact information - mailing address, telephone number, fax number, and email address. All quotations must be documented.

Prize

Top 10 sermons will be published in a special issue of JORA. The winning sermon will receive \$1,000 to be donated to the author's favorite organization that serves those affected by sexual and/or domestic violence.
